After choosing the concept of a solid color, it was important to use different textures of finishing materials that complement each other, which create a unique and exclusive character of the house.

AIRV TRANSLATION AGENCY

We are delighted to have collaborated with Rimartus design studio. To bring this project to reality by creating the bright and contemporary interior of the AIRV translation agency office. The interior has been revived in the cramped premises of Vilnius Old Town. This design theme combines old and new.

Against the background of the clean, newly formed white aesthetic, the white-painted multi-layered textures of the old bricks stand out. The masonry walls were specially exposed – after removing the old plaster, a disordered masonry of different layers was found, which became an interesting texture and a kind of heritage of the old construction.

“In the interior, we sought to create links with the architecture of the old town of Vilnius, to integrate the updated office interior into the existing context of the street and block, to give meaning to the combination of old and new.” – Rimantas Špokas.

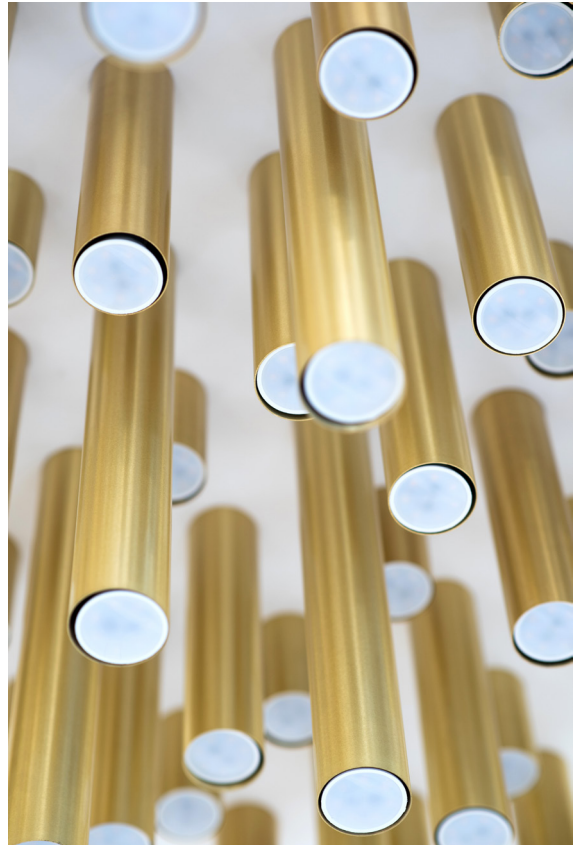
DERMATOLOGY CLINIC “ESTETUS”

There is huge competition in the market of the beauty industry. Every clinic not only has to provide best quality services but also has to be authentic and attractive from the design side. Clients firstly buy the “look and feel” of the clinic. The designer, Linas Mackevičius and his team, transformed incredibly the old dark premises of an insurance company into a spacious bright space. The area of 230 sq.m was divided into the main lobby, separate waiting areas, 8 treatment rooms and auxiliary premises.

White color with golden elements dominate All throughout the premises. All of the areas have bright yet cozy lighting, which coupled with mirrors expand the feeling of spaceusness. The reception area at the entrance zone stands out with an exclusive lamp. It was created by the designers of Elmarsa out of 75 separate light tubes of different lengths. No less important is the design of the showcase, the wardrobe and the mirror in the same reception area. All of the different elements are connected using the same materials: gold painted metal, white boards and stone plates. Same of the same materials are used in the procedure rooms but on a smaller scale. Elmarsa’s professional attitude towards the design helps the “Estetus” clinic to stand out from its competitors.









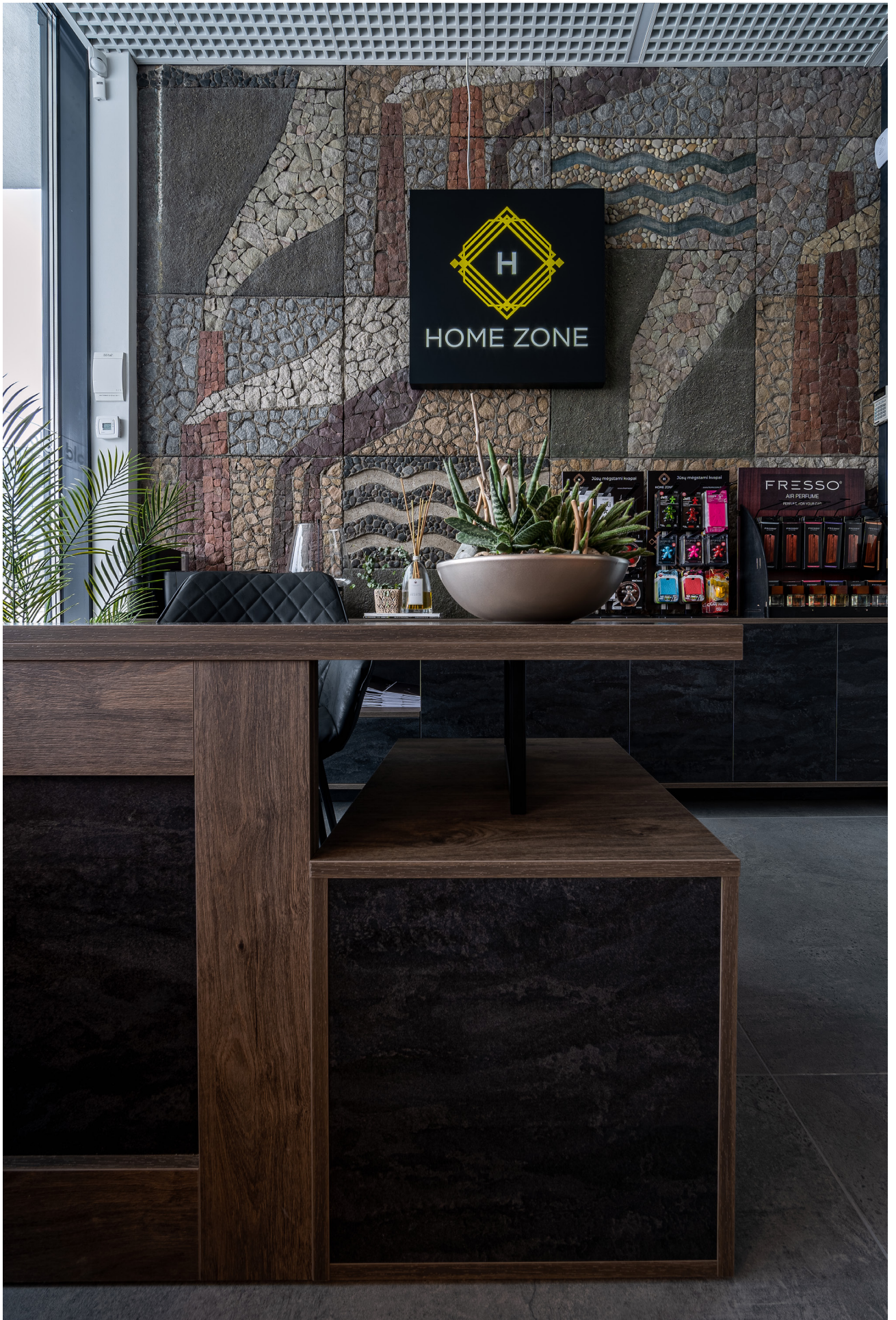

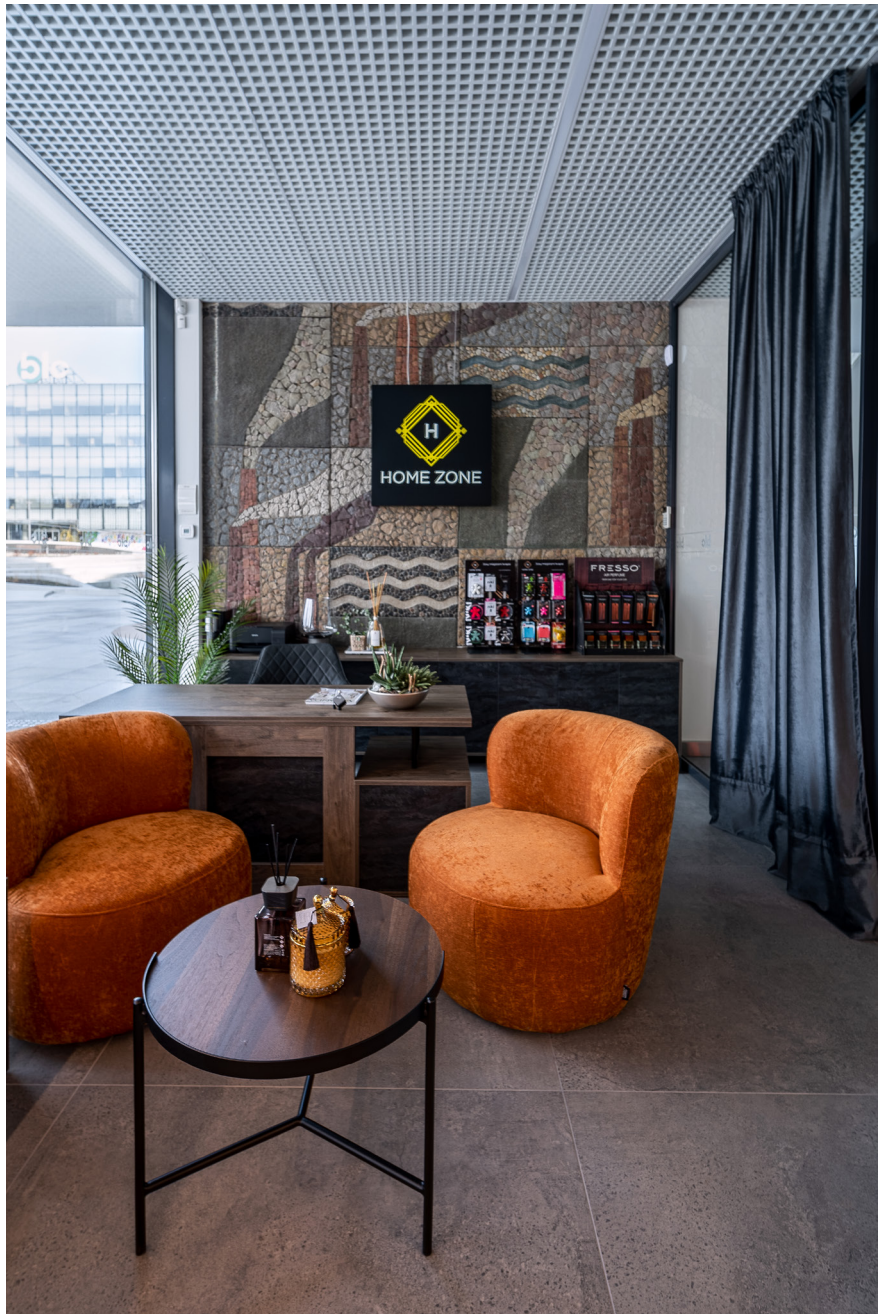

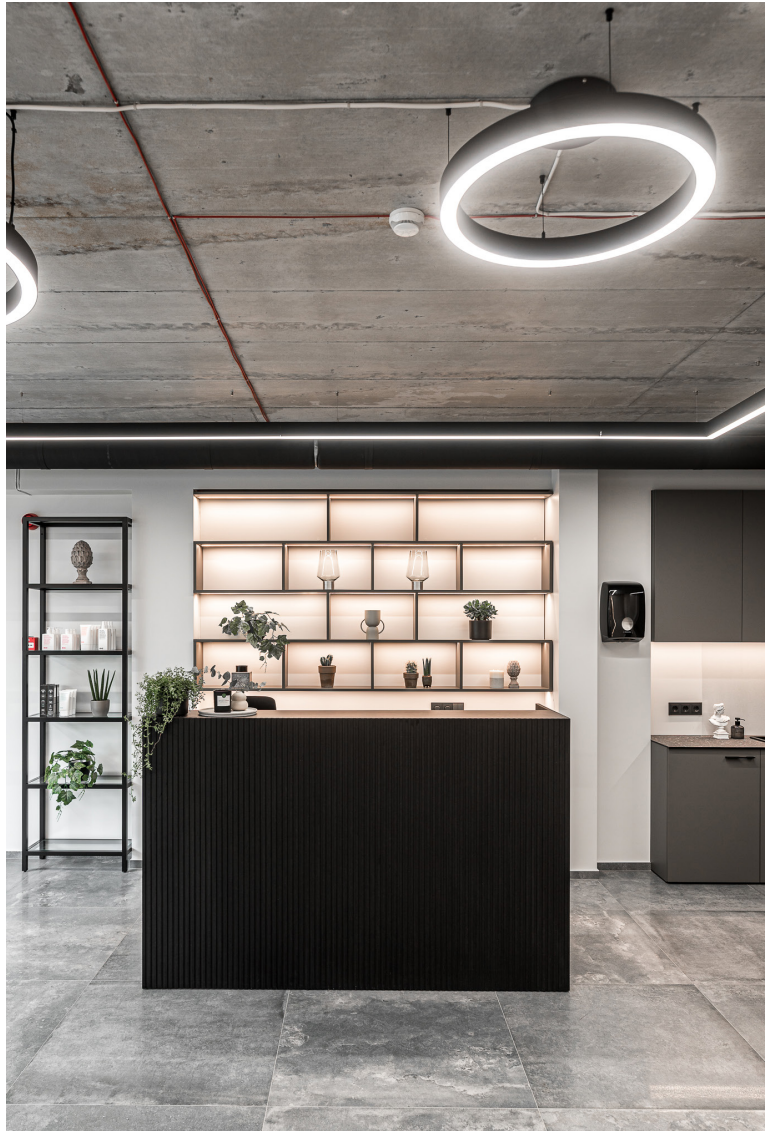

RŪTA SALDAINIŲ PARDUOTUVĖ

A sweets shop and cafe “Rūta” was designed in Vilnius old town, Trakai Street. The premises are small, consisting of only 46 sq.m., but Linas Mackevičius’ team had a goal to create a representative, cozy, and a comfortable space. The “Rūta” factory is unique to the Baltic region. It was established in 1913 as a family owned business and throughout the last century it has been producing original sweets, chocolate, and cakes. The assortment is very wide and varies according to the season so the shop had to be designed with universal exposition shelves. The space for bulk candies, boxes, chocolate figures, and even cakes had to be found. There is even a small sitting area by the windows to enjoy a cup of coffee with a sweet.

It was chosen to combine a stone pattern with dark brown wood and golden elements to create the look of the shop. “Rūta’s” production/ The goods pops out in this solid interior with a help of the LED lighting. As a mark of authenticity, the signature of the first owner of the factory is signed in golden ink on the counter desk.
